



## PROGRAMME FORMAT

Programme	<p>The Initial Teacher Education takes 3 years.</p> <p>Each year there are 2 Courses – one focusing on philosophy and Child Development from a Steiner-Waldorf perspective, and one focusing on curriculum and pedagogy. These are divided into Modules (or topics). The other strands, as mentioned above, weave through these.</p>
Exit points	<p>Successful completion of each Course is recognised by a Certificate of study and each year can be considered as an exit-point in its own right, e.g. to work as a Steiner Teaching Assistant.</p>
Minimum Entry requirements – <b>Teaching Route</b>	<p>B.A. or B.Sc.; English SCQF level 6 or equivalent; Maths SCQF level 5 or equivalent. English fluency, all skills, C1 CEFR or IELTS 6.5 (minimum of 5.5 in all skills)</p>
Location	<p>Edinburgh Steiner School EH10 5BR with one residential weekend at another location in May.</p>
Format	<p>Part-time, on Saturdays during Term-time, with independent study and assignments (approximately 10 -15 hours weekly)</p>
Delivery format	<p>Presentations with discussion, workshops and lectures.</p>
Assessments	<p>Each Module is individually assessed. This may be through Journaling, Presentation, written assignment or portfolio of work. Details for each module are in Student Handbook.</p>
Teaching Practice and Assessment	<p>18 weeks Teaching Practice is required over the 3 years on the Teaching Route. This is supported by experienced Steiner Teachers and will also be assessed through observation and written reflective practice.</p>
